
ADAP Client Federal Poverty Level (FPL) Direct Dispense (Uninsured) Enrollment: 15,305

ADAP Client Federal Poverty Level (FPL) Insurance Enrollment: 6,534









ADAP CLIENT VIRAL LOAD PROFILE 2nd Quarter (July-September 30, 2018) Total Clients Enrolled: 21,839















2nd Quarter (July 1-September 30, 2018) Total Co-Infected Clients: 17 Re-Infected Clients:1








ADAP Top 10 ARV Direct-Dispense (Uninsured) Expenditures 2nd Quarter (July 1-September 30, 2018)





2nd Quarter (July 1-September 30, 2018)






ADAP Top 10 ARV Emergency Dispenses 2nd Quarter (July 1-September 30, 2018) Total ARV Dispenses: 1,442




